MICHAEL (energetic) Alright, race you too the bench

ISA (annoyed) No (sighs)

ISA It's getting cold now: can I wear your coat?

MICHAEL (Jokingly) No you should have brought your own.

ISA

Please

MICHAEL Fine, but if I was single i'd be able to wear my own coat. ISA

(jokingly)

Yes but you'd also be single and alone with no one to talk too.

MICHAEL

True

A pause for a few seconds as they both look at the city lights.

ISA Shall we go out for dinner later?

MICHAEL Sure, your paying.

ISA (Raising her voice slightly and sounding a bit shocked) I paid last time!

MICHAEL (matching Isa's tone) No I did, and you said you'd get the next one.

ISA (in a lower tone) Fine
